

Neighborhood Watch and Safety Committee Charter

Mission

To assist in the protection of lives and property of the residents of the Villages of Rivershyre.

Responsibilities

1. Prepare a proposed annual budget and submit same to the Finance Committee prior to each fiscal year.
2. Provide continuous community education programs for the residents including, but not limited to, professional instruction by the Columbia County Sheriff's Department and the Martinez Volunteer Fire Department.
3. Obtain, install, and maintain "Crime Watch" signs from the Columbia County Sheriff's Department.
4. Provide a brochure with quick reference safety tips for residents. Utilize neighbor's telephone numbers from the Neighborhood Directory.
5. Recruit volunteers from within the community to serve as neighborhood watchpersons by periodically checking the area to insure the safety of the residents and, if required, study the feasibility of hiring private security personnel.
6. Coordinate with the Association President to be added to community meeting agendas, whenever possible, to provide a safety-related guest speaker. (The Committee will also call community meetings periodically for this purpose.)
7. Report any violation of vehicular speed limits, noise nuisance, or other incidents which constitute a safety hazard to the Columbia County Sheriff's Department and/or Board.
8. Provide committee information to the Social & Welcome Committee for the Community Newsletter on a routine basis.
9. Provide adequate, advanced notice of meetings.
10. Welcome and encourage participation of members (open membership).
11. Conduct any other regular business in accordance with the Bylaws and Covenants, or as directed by the Board.

12. Submit minutes and/or reports of meetings to the Board.
