Pool Committee - school is out, Summer is near and the Community Pool is open. Thanks to the special efforts of Mike Plankey and the rest of the Pool Committee, we were able to maintain the pool membership dues at a reasonable level by switching to a new pool service contractor. The new pool service contract does not include Life Guards so use of the pool will be "at your own risk" starting this year. You need to keep your children under close supervision at the pool since **the pool attendants are not working as Life Guards**. The attendants are responsible to take care of the pool and concession stand, watch to ensure that only authorized members enter the pool area and to ensure that people are following the pool rules. The attendants are empowered by the Pool Committee to ask anyone to leave the pool area if they are not following the pool rules or they are not able to provide proof of membership. A new key card lock has been installed to control unauthorized access

to the pool area. However, the new system depends on the honesty and the diligence of the members. When you open the gate, only allow members of your family or registered guests to enter and then close the gate securely behind you. **The Pool Rules, including those pertaining to guests, are posted at the pool and on the Rivershyre Website(www.rivershyre.org)**. Anyone entering the pool needs to have their own key card with them as proof of membership. Please be on the lookout for tail-gaters and do not allow any other persons to enter using your key.

Grounds and Lake Committee - Dan Johnson has taken over as Chairman this year. Jim McClain is the Secretary. Bill Ferguson is working on setting up a sprinkler service contract. Guy Hoffman is in charge of the Tennis Courts and is looking into getting the cracks repaired. If you have any concerns about the common areas and would like to help out on the committee, please call Dan at 651-1603.

Architectural Control Committee - Jeff Butler is Chairman. Bill Clark has joined Jim McClain as the active members on the committee. They have plenty of work to do enforcing the covenants and could use some help. If you are concerned about the appearance of our community and want to help do something about it please contact Jeff, Jim or Bill.

Social & Welcome Committee - Martha Kapfhammer is the Chairperson and the committee has sponsored numerous events this year including a Mardi Gras Party, the Easter Egg Hunt and the community Yard Sale. If you would like to help plan or assist on some of the social events that help make Rivershyre a special place to live please contact Martha or just show up at the next meeting.

Finance Committee - Ray Jasniecke, Holly Bullock and myself have been working on the 2003 budget and the long term savings plan. This year we started using the Quick Books program for our bookkeeping. I updated our computer file to include our financial records for the last 2 years so we could use computer reports for preparing our budgets. Our 2002 tax return has been submitted to our tax preparer Mattison Verdery.

Neighborhood Watch Committee - is essentially defunct due to the lack of active committee members. Mike Paluba is the Board Liason and would like to hear from anyone that is interested in re-activating this important resource. Mike has a background in Emergency Planning and would like to work with anyone interested in helping maintain a secure environment in our neighborhood.

Board News - Holly Bullock will be taking over as the Board Treasurer from Ray Jasniecke. Ray is not able to continue as Treasurer because of his new job assignment. Mike Paluba has put together a set of binders for the board members. Susan Perfect is working with Martha to get the Directory updated and issued. In the next couple months the Board will be reviewing and approving the 2003 budget and getting ready for the 2003 HOA meeting. As part of the budget review, we will be looking at Reserve requirements based on the long range savings plan being developed by the Finance Committee.

Any homeowners in good standing are eligible to serve on the Board or one of the standing committees. We will be asking for volunteers at the HOA meeting. Some of the current Board members terms will be up this year so we are interested in getting some new nominees to serve on the Board.
